Facilitator Instructions:

- 1. Make sure participants have something to write with
- 2. Print 1 copy of the "30 Circles" worksheet for each participant
- 3. Give participants 1-2 minutes to fill in as many circles as possible by turning them in to UNIQUE and RECOGNIZABLE objects
 - "Unique" means no duplicates (they can't turn every circle in to the same object)
 - "Recognizable" means the objects they create must exist in our world
- 4. Provide them with a "freebie" example of turning their first circle in to a smiley face to get them started:



OPTIONAL:

Determine which participants think they created the most objects from the circles. Ask the person with the top number to say out loud what their objects were while everyone crosses off the objects they also had. Then ask the person with the second highest number of objects to do the same and so on until you've determine the "winner" based on who had the most unique objects that no one else had.
